2015-2016 Retreats

The Courage to Lead® Program for school administrators (principals, assistant principals, and other district administrators) is a personal and professional renewal program that offers school leaders time and space to reflect on the complex, challenging, and changing dimensions of their leadership experiences.

Participants are asked to commit themselves to attending two to four consecutive seasonal retreats where they will explore the “heart of the educator” through sharing stories from their own journeys, reflecting on their practice, and drawing upon the insights of poets, storytellers, and diverse cultural traditions.



Retreat Cycle Details

The two 2015 retreats meet Thursday-Saturday, September 24-26 and Thursday-Saturday, December 3-5. The complete 2016 cycle dates are Thursday-Saturday, March 3-5 and Sunday-Tuesday, June 26-28; Thursday-Saturday, September 22-24 and Thursday-Saturday, December 1-3. All retreats meet at the Menucha Retreat and Conference Center in Corbett, Oregon.
