- August 25 Revenue Forecast
- Late September Possible Special Session
- **Sept/Nov/January** Interim Legislative Committee and Task Force Meetings
- February 1 2022 Session Convenes



## **COSA Legislative Priorities**

2021 Session - Budget

- COSA Goal State School Fund: \$9.6 billion
  - Final Budget: \$9.3 billion (SB 5514)
- COSA Goal Protect Student Success Act Investments
  - Final Budget for Student Investment Account (SIA): \$892 million
  - Final Budget for High School Success (M98): \$311 million
  - ESDs supporting SSA: \$41.1 million
  - > Additional Equity Initiative Investments: \$22 million
- K-12 Facilities Investments
  - SCIM: \$125 million; Seismic Grants: \$110 million; Broadband: \$17.5 million
- Key Grant in Aid Funding Regional Programs and YCEP/JDEP
  - Regional Programs: \$65.2 million; YCEP/JDEP: \$8 million increase (SB 5513)

2021 Session - Policy

- Retaining Culturally and Linguistically Diverse Teachers
  - House Bill 2001 Passed
- Linguistic Inclusion
  House Bill 2056 Passed
- LGBTQ2SIA+ Student Success Plan
  - > Senate Bill 52 Passed
- Small High School Grant and Dorm School Exchange Students
  House Bill 2330 Passed

## **COSA Legislative Priorities**

2021 Session - Policy

- Virtual Charter School Extended ADMw
  - Senate Bill 743 Passed
- Every Student Belongs
  - House Bill 2697 Passed
- Tribal Regalia
  - House Bill 2052 Passed
- Student Success Act Improvements
  - House Bill 2060 Passed
- High School Diploma Requirements Review
  - Senate Bill 744 Passed

#### **COSA Legislative Updates & Unfinished Work** Legislative Work for 2022

- Class Size as a Mandatory Subject of Bargaining
  - > SB 580 Passed but amended to only include Title I Schools
- Racial Equity and Justice Student Collaborative
  - House Bill 3363 Did Not Pass
- Mandating School Board Member/Supt. Training
  - Senate Bill 334 Did Not Pass
- Additional Funding for Wildfire Impacted Districts
  - House Bill 2630 Did Not Pass

## 2021 Session – SSF Advocacy

How did your advocacy change the budget?

- November 2020 Current Service Level \$8.97 billion
- **December 2020** Governor's Budget \$9.1 billion
- March 2021 Co-Chairs Budget \$9.1 billion
- May 2021 Final SSF Budget passed at \$9.3 billion
- Information we used from districts:
  - 1. How much is the budget deficit for each district/ESD?
  - 2. How many teaching (or staff) positions is that equivalent to?
  - 3. How many calendar days is that equivalent to?
- COSA Member Advocacy added \$303 million to the State School Fund Budget
