The Principal Licensure + MEd program totals 46 credits over two years. Candidates seek licensure through TSPC with COSA/UO's assistance once all coursework is completed.

Candidates are required to attend the Internship Orientation in spring of their first year and, during their second year, are encouraged to attend COSA-sponsored conferences.

MEd NOTE: The two required MEd classes are offered in both Summer terms. We recommend taking one MEd class each summer, along with the required Principal Licensure class.
