

system, the development of skills for classroom observation, and the capacity to identify and provide results-oriented reports and feedback that are credible and convincing.

Four major strands are woven together throughout each session and in the field-work experience:

- o Examining and experimenting with multiple data sources
- Defining high standards and expectations for teaching and learning
