ELPA21 Screener Development

- Screener design and development continues with our partners at UCLA CRESST
- Still a 3-stage model, including a short "get to know you" phase that includes practice and orientation to the task.
- Screener scheduled to debut in August, 2016 on an outside platform (not Oregon's current vendor)

ELPA21 Screener Implementation

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- Oregon will not require the ELPA21 screener until mid-school year during 2016-17
 - Exact dates to be determined
- Oregon school districts should plan for usual screener usage of the commercial screeners (IPT, WMLS, etc.)
- ODE plans an ELPA21 screener roll-out with a concurrent data study
 - Information to follow for participation

ELPA21 PD Modules



- Rirst 3 modules were delivered late fall 2015
 - Introduction
 - **Task Analysis**
 - **S** ELP Standards
- Rinal 3 modules will be delivered in fall 2016
 - CS PLDs (October)
 - S Formative Assessment (November)
 - Reflection (December)

ELPA21 at UCLA/CRESST

- Negotiations are underway to create a permanent home at UCLA/CRESST
- Similar to Smarter Balanced, Oregon would sign a
 Memo of Understanding to join ELPA21 at
 UCLA/CRESST
 - Receive access to item bank and calibrations
 - Participate in future field testing
 - Research opportunities for future improvements / benefits for ELs
