- Purpose:
 - To develop conscious competence in communicating high expectation messages to every student
 - To apply knowledge and skills in developing students' believe in the growth mindset
 - Apply the concepts of "areas of performance,"
 "repertoire," and" matching" to develop students' belief in the growth mindset
 - o Expand/refresh your repertoire of teaching strategies
- Objectives:
 - Teach the concept of growth mindset and brain malleability to students
 - Use words and actions in regularly recurring arenas of classroom life that send high expectations messages to students about your belief in their capacity to learn at high levels
 - Incorporate growth mindset language as an integral part of your teaching
 - Explicitly teach learning strategies and connect them to effective effort
