Oregon Outstanding Assistant Principal of the Year

PURPOSE

To publicly recognize the outstanding leadership of elementary assistant principals in Oregon.

CRITERIA FOR SELECTION

- Nominee must be an active assistant principal at the time of the application deadline.
- Nominee must have been an active assistant principal for at least two years.
- Nominee must contribute to the well-being of the educational community.
- Nominee must contribute to a positive and motivating environment for others.
- Nominee must have a strong record of service (in both school and community) and be recognized as a leader.
- Nominee must exhibit exceptional leadership in a particular school program and/or is heavily involved in finding a solution to a problem faced by the school.

Please answer all five questions below: (3 pages maximum)

- 1. List administrative position(s) held. Include title, district, length of service.
- 2. Describe in some detail and give specific examples of accomplishments as they relate to contributing to the well-being of the educational community.
- 3. List and explain how the nominee has contributed to a positive and motivating environment for others.
- 4. List the nominee's record of service in both school and community and how he/she is recognized as a leader.
- 5. Describe how the nominee exhibits exceptional leadership in a particular school program and/or how they are involved in finding a solution to a problem faced by the school.

GENERAL PROCEDURE

- 1. Nomination materials will be sent to all COSA members.
- 2. Nominators will contact nominees to obtain information required if necessary. It is also possible to nominate without the nominee knowing.
- 3. The OESPA Executive Committee will act as the selection committee by judging the materials and by personal contact with the home districts of the nominees, if desired.
- 4. The Oregon winner will be recognized at the Annual COSA Conference in June.
- 5. Members of the OESPA Executive Committee may be considered for nomination but will be recused from the entire process.

TIMELINE

- 1. Materials will be available in March 2025.
- 2. Completed nomination forms must be uploaded by 11:59 pm on Tuesday, April 8, 2025.
- 3. The nominees and Oregon winner will be notified in May and be honored at the COSA Conference in June.
