

Canby School District has a K-12 enrollment of 4,762 students with a 2014-2015 general fund budget of \$43,100,725. Unifying four smaller school districts in July 1994, and redefining school attendance boundaries in 2005, the district currently consists of five K-6 schools,



one K-8 school, one middle school (7-8), and one high school (9-12). The district is proud of its progressive educational system providing a comprehensive program for students of all abilities and grade levels. Integrated technology curriculum and fine arts opportunities are provided throughout the district. Students are afforded the opportunity to achieve at their highest level. After-school activities, including both basic educational classes and enrichment
