The selected candidate will work closely with the Director of Student Services, Building Administration, Dean of Students, and Special Education Teachers to create a positive environment for skill building and social/emotional growth.

7.5 hours per day for the 2024-2025 school year. Position begins ASAP. Ability to lift 60 lbs.
